In lecture, very interesting points on Linear Algebra were raised and were often the motivation for the course material. The course will help you see things in linear algebra from the ground up and although things may seem unnecessary and dry at first, as you work through the material you will appreciate what it takes to build a theory. Psets are doable and interesting and enough help is provided. Overall, really organised (definitely better than 202 in that regard from what I hear) and interesting course. Strongly recommend.
